THE HEALING MINISTRY OF JESUS

- A. Isaiah 61:1-3; Luke 4:16-22
- B. Luke 7:18-23
- C. Acts 10:38

PATTERNS FOR JESUS' MINISTRY

- A. Jesus' works were motivated by compassion.
(Matthew 9: 36-37; 14: 14; 20: 29-34)
- B. Jesus seemed to be more able to heal in the presence of faith in Him and in His power to heal. (Matthew 8: 8-13; 92; Mark 5: 28-31)
- C. Jesus was aware of times where the Spirit was especially ready to move in power.(Luke 5:17)
- D. Jesus was always willing to heal those who came to Him with faith.
(Matthew 8: 1-4; 8: 5-7; Mark 7: 24-30)
- E. Jesus did not do miracles for those who wanted only to test Him or be entertained. (Matthew 12: 28-42)
- F. Resistance on any grounds to healing the needy grieved the Lord.
(Mark 3: 1-6; Luke 13: 10-17)
- G. Jesus used many patterns and methods of healing:
 - A touch (Matthew 8:15)
 - A prayer (John 11: 41-42)
 - A declaration (Luke 7: 9-10)
 - A word or command (Matthew 8: 8-13; Luke 5: 24-25; 6: 10)
 - A touch and command (Luke 5:13; Matthew 8:3; 9: 29)
 - Someone touching Him (Matthew 14: 34-36; Luke 8: 44)
 - Using spittle or mud (Mark 7: 33; 8: 23; John 9: 7)
 - Doing an act of faith (Luke 6: 10; 7: 17; John 9: 7)
- H. Jesus most often healed in public, though sometimes He would withdraw and heal in private. (Matthew 12:15, Mark 7:33)

- I. Jesus frequently directed those He healed to get medical proof. (Leviticus 13: 49; 14: 2-32; Matthew 8: 1-4)
- J. Jesus did not necessarily equate sin and sickness. (John 9: 1-3)
- K. Sometimes Jesus had to pray more than once for the person needing to be healed. (Mark 8: 22-26)

BASIC HEALING MOTIVE AND METHOD OF JESUS:

Relationship with the Father (John 3: 34)

1. He works together with the Father. (John 8: 19)
2. He does nothing on His own initiative. (John 7: 16)
3. He acts and speaks only on what He sees and hears from the Father. (John 5: 19)
4. Jesus works for the Father's honour, not His own. (John 7: 18)

PRAYER MINISTRY MODEL

STEP ONE - INTERVIEW

To discover why they have come forward, listening to them and to God.

STEP TWO - DECIDE WHAT YOU ARE DEALING WITH

- What is the reason for the need or condition?
- Is it a spiritual, physical or emotional need?
- Is there a need for repentance, confession, forgiveness?
- Would it help to get them to verbalise their request to God in your presence?
- Do they have need to forgive someone else?

STEP 3 PRAYER SELECTION

- What kind of prayer will I need to pray to help this person?
- Prayer directed toward God - ask for Holy Spirit's presence and/or healing.
- Prayer in the Spirit
- Prayer from God - command of faith.
- Authoritative prayer to demons or to condition.

STEP FOUR - GET PRAYING

- Be sensitive to whatever the Holy Spirit is doing.
- Don't have your eyes shut all the time - need to see what is happening.
- If emotional response - encourage release.
- If person falls under God's power stay with them and work with whatever the Holy Spirit -indicates.
- Ask questions - to see how they are getting on.
- Some people are programmed to failure - or are not tuned in to their own bodies.
- Don't be afraid to ask for help if you feel out of your depth.
- Sometimes there will be demonic response - pray accordingly.
- Believe in your authority.

4 ways to know when to stop praying:

1. When the person you are praying for indicates it is over.
2. When the Spirit tells you it is over.
3. When you cannot think of anything else to say.
4. When you have prayed for everything and it seems you have not gained any ground.

STEP FIVE - AFTER PRAYER INPUT AND DIRECTION
